

Proposed Sunday Dialogue Outline – Wosk Centre for Dialogue

In order to provide an engaging program for the assembled IAMPC and Mayors for Peace delegates, Greater Vancouver Regional District Mayors and Councilors and other guests, the following proposal is intended to incorporate the opportunity to report city visions and engage in meaningful dialogue.

Each participating city will be asked to produce for distribution a one-page outline of the examples of peace and sustainability activities and actions on-going or planned. They will not be asked to read it but are free to reference the document during the dialogue.

The proposal is to set up four city presentations of inspirational peace activities of 15 minutes maximum duration to be followed by a chaired discussion for 60 minutes. There will be two panels in the morning and two in the afternoon. Respondents will be asked to discuss applicability of the examples as presented and how they might apply in their own cities and regions. Respondents are free to reference their own city's activities and actions in their three to five minute commentaries. The co-chairs will manage the debate.
