## JOINT STATEMENT OF CITIES ABOUT CITY HALL SARAJEVO

- Taking into consideration the importance of the historical building – City Hall Sarajevo (1892), convicting brutal destroying of this object in the period between 1992 and 1995, Peace Messenger Cities declare: that they will follow, promote and participate in preserving and conservation of this building – City Hall, which is enlisted in the list of top 100 monuments the most threatened in the year 2008 by the foundation World Monuments Watch.
- City Hall Sarajevo is proclaimed as National monument by Decision of Commission to Preserve National Monuments and it is extremely valuable cultural-historical and national good. Special attention should be given to its protection and purpose, because the way how it will be promoted, and content that will be within, have an effect on the whole society and as well on the life quality of present and future generations in Bosnia and Herzegovina.
- We, Peace Messenger Cities, are ready, in accordance with our possibilities, to give support by the help of which City Hall Sarajevo will be additionally enriched.
- Sarajevo City is engaged to ensure one chamber for International Association Peace Messenger Cities (IAPMC) in City Hall Sarajevo, where the activities of this association will be presented.
